**DISTRICT CASCADING ON TEACHING AT THE RIGHT LEVEL (TaRL):
 STRENGTHENING FOUNDATIONAL LITERACY AND NUMERACY THROUGH
 ASSESSMENT, GROUPING, AND TARGETED INSTRUCTION**

TO: All Public Schools District Supervisors/District in Charge

- With reference to Division Memorandum No. 253, s. 2026 dated May 5, 2026 and in response to the critical need to strengthen foundational literacy and numeracy among early grade learners, the District Office will conduct the Cascading Workshop for all untrained Key Stage 1 teachers on Teaching at the Right Level (TaRL) on June 4-5, 2026 at their respective District Offices/designated schools.
- This initiative is anchored in the evidence-based pedagogical approach developed by Pratham International, the strategic recommendations of the 2021 World Bank Synthesis Report, and the legal mandates of the ARAL Law.
- The district cascading aims to equip untrained teachers with actionable interventions, specifically focusing on:
 - Implementing TaRL's core literacy and numeracy routines, diagnostic assessments, and data-driven learner grouping strategies.
 - Integrating the AHA EILS framework to weave socio-emotional learning into daily routines.
 - Operationalizing the Suporta Eskwela Club at the school level.
- The facilitators of this training are those who attended the division training at Sibugay Hotel last May 12-15, 2026, and those who were trained last 2025.
- School Heads must adjust schedules to ensure that participating teachers can attend the cascading sessions without disrupting critical school operations.
- Meals, snacks, and travel expenses incurred by participants shall be charged against local school funds/MOOE, subject to usual accounting and auditing procedures.
- Attached are the list of trained teachers per district and training matrix.
