The School-Based Immunization (SBI) is a nationwide program of the Department of Health (DOH), in coordination with the Department of Education (DepEd) that aims to provide protection against vaccine-preventable diseases (VPDs) such as measles, rubella, tetanus, diphtheria and human papilloma virus (HPV) among school children Grades 1, 4 and 7 in all public schools.
2. In view of the foregoing, the Office of the Provincial Health Officer of Zamboanga Sibugay respectfully invites all **16 District Supervisors/District In-Charge and all school nurses to attend the Orientation on School-Based Immunization Program on June 25-28, 2026 at Roderic's Resort, Ipil, Zamboanga Sibugay.**

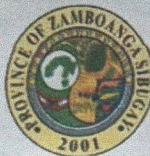


